## Expert Lecture on "Windows Azure"

A first goal is to make sure that operators and administrators have access to the same diagnostic information from the cloud-based version of aExpense as they have from the on-premises and IaaS hosted versions of the application.

The second goal is to continue to automate the deployment process to Azure. As the project moves forward, Adatum wants to be able to deploy versions of aExpense to Azure without needing to manually edit the configuration files, or use the Azure Management Portal. This will make deploying to Azure less error-prone, and easier to perform in an automated build environment
