Provision to 'Forgo' the continuous assessment component of the total marks

A regular student who has obtained FF grade in ESE in the current semester of study, in one or more courses, due to any reason whatsoever;

OR

A regular student who has been detained by the Department/ Institute from appearing for examination in ESE and ESSE in the current semester of study, in one or more courses due to any reason whatsoever (except unfair means cases in examination);

Shall be provided with an option to 'Forgo' the continuous Assessment component of evaluation (TA + MSE/MSIE).

Under this provision, the student may appear as an ex-student for an immediate successive ESSE or in the subsequent year's ESE/ ESSE (odd to odd / even to even) for that particular course(s). The student who opts for this provision will be examined on the basis of total marks earned by him/ her in the respective examination for which he/she appears, in the following manner –

(1) MCA and B. Tech programs:

Theory Course(s): Maximum 40 % of the total continuous assessment marks (MSE/ MSIE + TA) will be awarded if a student earns $\geq 40\%$ of the maximum marks of the course under consideration in ESSE/ ESE, else continuous assessment marks will be in proportion to the actual marks rounded off to an immediate higher number.

Example:

Marks earned by students in ESSE/ESE, out of 60	< 40% marks			$\geq 40\%$ marks				
	6	12	18	24	30	36	42	60
Award of Continuous assessment component, out of 40	$6*40/60=4$	8	12	16	16	16	16	16
Total marks, out of 100	10	20	30	40	46	52	58	76

Practical Course(s): Maximum 50 % of the continuous assessment marks, rounded off to an immediate higher number, will be awarded if a student earns $\geq 50\%$ of the maximum marks of the course under consideration in ESSE/ ESE, else continuous assessment marks will be in proportion to the actual marks.

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Example:

Marks earned by students in practical course, out of 25	< 50%marks			≥ 50 % marks		
	4	8	12	16	20	24
Award of Continuous assessment component, out of 25	4	8	12	13	13	13
Total marks, out of 50	8	16	24	29	33	37

(2) M. Tech programs:

Theory Course(s): Maximum 50 % of the total continuous assessment marks (MSE/ MSIE + TA) will be awarded if a student earns $\geq 40\%$ of the maximum marks of the course under consideration in ESSE/ ESE, else continuous assessment marks will be in proportion to the actual marks rounded off to an immediate higher number.

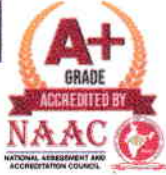
Example:

Marks earned by students in ESSE/ESE out of 60	< 40% marks			≥ 40 % marks				
	6	12	18	24	30	36	42	60
Award of Continuous assessment component, out of 40	$6 \cdot 40/60 = 4$	8	12	20	20	20	20	20
Total marks out of 100	10	20	30	44	50	56	62	80

Practical Course(s): Maximum 50 % of the continuous assessment marks, rounded off to an immediate higher number, will be awarded if a student earns $\geq 50\%$ of maximum marks of the course under consideration in ESSE/ ESE, else continuous assessment marks will be in proportion to the actual marks.

Example:

Marks earned by students in practical Course, out of 25	< 50% marks			≥ 50 % marks		
	4	8	12	16	20	24
Award of Continuous assessment component, out of 25	4	8	12	13	13	13
Total out of 50	8	16	24	29	33	37



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(3) MBA program: Maximum 50 % of the total continuous assessment marks (MSE/ MSIE + TA) will be awarded if a student earns $\geq 50\%$ of maximum marks of the course under consideration in ESSE/ ESE, else continuous assessment marks will be in proportion to the actual marks rounded off to an immediate higher number.

Example:

Marks earned by students in ESSE/ESE, out of 60	< 50% marks				$\geq 50\%$ marks			
	6	12	18	24	30	36	42	60
Award of Continuous assessment component, out of 40	$6 \times 40 / 60 = 4$	8	12	16	20	20	20	20
Total marks, out of 100	10	20	30	40	50	56	62	80

In order to avail this provision, the student will have to select 'Forgo' option in the online Examination Application form so as to forgo the continuous assessment marks component.

Note: 'Forgo' option once exercised for a particular course(s) shall be final and binding on the concerned student for the immediate ESSE and all the subsequent examinations of that course(s). Students are, therefore, advised to assess the pros and cons of Forgo before opting for this provision.

Important notes:

Note 1: Grade allotment (relative / absolute) will be based on applicable clause(s) of existing examination rules and regulations.

Note 2: The grade sheet will reflect the Forgo option exercised by the student in the form of a superscripted asterisk and a footnote:

*Asterisk in grade column \rightarrow BC**
