NEWS FROM KALEIDOSCOPE CULTURAL CLUB

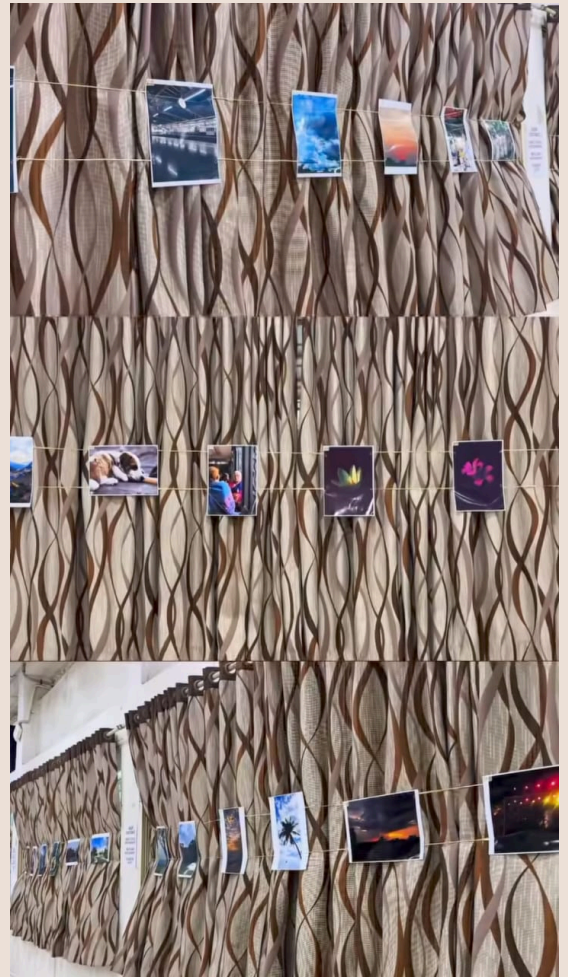
