### “Expert Lecture on Ethical Week”

Department of Information Technology, Prof. Ram Meghe Institute of Technology and Research Badnera conducted expert lecture on Ethics and Moral values by Dr. P. V. Ingole HOD, Department of Information Technology on 12<sup>th</sup> & 13<sup>th</sup> September 2023 for B. E. Second Year Section A & Second Year Section B respectively. This activity is conducted under the ethical week celebration program. Dr. P. V. Ingole explained in detailed about the Ethics and Morality. He told students that along with the good technocrat one should possess ethical and moral values to become good human being and good citizen of India. He elaborated that Ethics is an attempt to guide human conduct and it is also **an attempt to help man in leading good life** by applying moral principles. Ethics refers to well based standards of right and wrong that **prescribe what humans ought to do**, usually in terms of rights, obligations, benefits to society, fairness, or specific virtues.

The objective of taking lectures on ethics and moral values is to imbibe the students that an engineer whether he works individually or works for a company, has to go through some ethical issues, mostly under the conditions

arising in design and testing departments, or may be on the issues involving the manufacturing, sales and services. Questions related to morality also arise during supervision and team works. The ethical decisions and moral values of an engineer need to be considered because the decisions of an engineer have an impact the products and services how safe they are to use, the company and its shareholders who believe in the goodwill of the company, the public and the society who trusts the company regarding the benefits of the people. **Ethics does provide good tools for thinking about moral issues.** Ethics can provide a moral map. Most moral issues get us pretty worked up - think of illegal human relationships, abortion of girl child, religion conversion. Because these are such emotional issues we often let our hearts do the arguing while our brains just go with the flow. **Ethics provides us with a moral map, a frame work that we can use to find our way through difficult issues.**

Ethics can pinpoint a disagreement. Using the framework of ethics, two people who are arguing a moral issue can often find amicable solution.

Total 67 students from B. E second year sec. A & 64 students from B. E second year sec. B were attended the session. Lecture on Ethics and Moral values was attended by the entire student. It was good interactive session between teachers of Second year of both sections have taken effect from the students.

### “Flipped Classroom Activity”

Flipped classroom activity is a model of blended learning, known as a typical classroom of reversing the giving and receiving of knowledge. Before this class, students are required to learn the lesson content at home using the materials the teachers have prepared in advance. 
## VISIT TO OLD AGE HOME
